PRODUCT IDENTIFICATION:

- All individual sheet rears and product packaging marked "Non Structural"
- Sheet corners coloured **ORANGE** for easy identification in pallet racking
- Packets marked on long side with "Non Structural" (NS)

SUGGESTED APPLICATIONS

- Temporary hoardings
- Non structural packaging
- Dog kennels, letter boxes, doll houses, etc

TREATMENT

H3 CCA treated plywood is treated in accordance with AS/NZS 1604.3 and is suitable for use in exposed, above ground applications.

Treatment may leave a green tinge and fillet marks on the sheet surface and treated products are not suitable for use with stains and clear coats.

PRODUCT LIMITATIONS

Non structural plywood must not be used for any application requiring a building consent or where structural performance is required.

Non structural plywood must not be used in any structural or load bearing application as outlined under the NZ Building Code. Non structural plywood is not compliant with AS/NZS 2269.

Where structural plywood is required, use EcoPLY® or Shadowclad® branded structural plywood.

Non structural plywood may contain sheet imperfections including but not limited to edge damage, core overlaps and surface inconsistencies covering up to 5% of the sheet body.

Imperfections of this nature are to be expected in this plywood grade and not covered by structural product warranties.
